WHAT IS THE CCA'S SCHOOLS AND YOUNG PEOPLE PROGRAMME?

CCA began their Schools and Young People Programme last year and is one of the ways CCA aims to increase access to contemporary art for young people. The Learning Space is on the ground floor of the building is a designated space for workshops, school trips and drop-in activities for young people. We are looking for two artists to each deliver a series of three workshops for the 2025 Summer programme.

WHAT WE ARE LOOKING FOR...

We are looking to support artists whose practice already concerns social/community groups. We want these workshops to be a development of your practice and a genuine collaboration with the young people. You will lead 3 workshops to develop a body of work. We want to encourage young people to collaborate, express themselves and learn new skills.

We expect you to have...

- Ongoing creative practice
- Experience of working and collaborating with young people
- Understanding of different accessibility requirements
- Aware and understanding of safeguarding
- A current freelancer PVG is preferable however, if you do not have one, then we will organise this with you

SESSION DETAILS

- Aimed at 7-13 year olds
- Each workshop is 2 hours long, 1 - 3 pm
- Children are dropped off at the beginning of the session and picked up at the end
- Encourage young people to think about the power of the arts - this can be interpreted in any way you wish
- You will lead the workshop, and the Young People Coordinator will assist and manage safeguarding and behavioural matters.
- There will be a maximum of 10 young people in a group at a time.

Families sign their children up for the workshops through our online booking system. The CCA will manage child protection, first-aid and bookings. You will work with the same young people across the 3 days.

FEES

A one-off fee of £855 to deliver 3 sessions over one week.

There is an additional materials fee of up to £150, which will be managed by the CCA's Schools and Young People Coordinator.

HOW TO APPLY

- Email submissions@cca-glasgow.com with your application. A brief outline of each session, including activities, materials and aims (up to 500 words).
- CV (max 2 A4 pages)
- Up to 5 examples of previous work with community groups. Examples of previous work could be session plans, activity sheets or learning projects you've worked on.
- What block of workshops you are able to deliver.
Block 1, 8 - 10 July OR Block 2, 29 - 31 July
- If you have a valid PVG certificate. If you do not have a PVG certificate, we can organise this with you.
- Title your email: Young People Summer Holiday Programme.
